



Basic Emergency Response Trailer



B.E.R.T. is a prototype High-tech Low-cost amphibious Emergency Services and Disaster Relief Trailer. It is designed to be towed in “units” up to six by almost any vehicle or boat. This enables a small team or responders the ability to deploy them rapidly to the areas of need.

B.E.R.T. is intended to provide basic services and act as a local communication center to link and network neighborhoods, developments and small communities during the first seventy- two hours after a disaster or national emergency. The trailer then can continue to function until utilities are restored.

B.E.R.T. will be equipped with Citizens Band, GPS, marine radio, AM- FM radio, as well as weather radio and two way radio. Each trailer will have the ability to produce it’s own electricity. The solar panels can produce up to one kilowatt hour and the wind generator can produce an additional four hundred watts.

These will supplement and recharge the fourteen kilowatt battery bank. Interior and Exterior lighting will help to promote a gathering and secure area.

The trailer can provide enough water for one hundred people for two days and can be equipped to produce an additional fifty gallons of potable water per day. The trailer will also, provide hot water for food and drink. Each trailer will have four bunks to be used as a shelter or triage/waiting area until Emergency Services arrive. The trailer will also have first aid kits ; items can be stored inside such as blankets, food, generator, pump, etc.
