The shelter is shipped to you on a flat pallet that would easily fit in the bed of a standard pick-up truck.. Assembly is required.

The panels are easily bolted together on site using tools that most homeowners already have.

The site prep work involves digging a hole to the dimensions of the shelter. This can be dug by hand, 2-people could do this in approximately 2 days if the soil is sandy, or dug by a septic tank installer.

A seal strip is installed over all mating surfaces and all panels are thru-bolted together.

Once the structure is assembled and all bolts tightened, the hole can be back-filled and the remaining soil used to cover the shelter.

First State Storm/Tornado/Fallout Shelter

The First State storm shelter is an affordable, modular, customizable structure for partial or complete underground installation. Each module consists of a 4' X 8' interlocking floor section, 2-side walls and roof panels. These rugged light-weight panels are easily assembled using basic hand tools.

Your shelter can be customized to length by adding modules, end panels, door panels, stairs or ladder access modules of different depths. Either 4', 6' or 8' modules are available.

The shelter is designed as a temporary safe-haven during severe storms, tornados, hurricanes or other disasters.

The shelter can be equipped with its own power source and can be re-charged via AC, solar and/or wind generation. Independent communication systems such as CB, Marine radio, AM-FM radio as well as weather and 2-way radio, can be added to keep you in touch with the outside world.

These can enable the shelter to serve as temporary housing until other or arrangements are made.
